This is the 13th year of Open Studios North Fife. From award winning ceramicists and painters to jewellers, weavers and textile artists, and those working in glass, metal, wood, photography and pencil – we have them all.

Open Studios North Fife was set up in 2005 to promote the wealth of talent of professional artists and makers in the area. We started with 14 people and now number over 70.

Keep this brochure for future reference. Many of the artists welcome visits to their studios throughout the year.

As Artists and Craftspeople we manage our studios and our careers in lots of different ways. Some of us sell our work close to home and others also supply international markets. Some make multiples to specific designs while others are commissioned for bespoke pieces or create one-off paintings and sculpture.

The scale we work on varies too. Ranging from small intimate pieces to large architectural installations. But what we all have in common is the strong drive to make our own work and a real passion for the materials we use.





From Freuchie, take the B936 as if you're going to Falkland. We're the last right turn as you're leaving Newton of Falkland. See you there!

Access: There is parking in front of the house and access is via the front door.

Points of interest: All welcome. We're a mile from Falkland and a mile from Freuchie. There is a play area across the road with fantastic views of the Lomond Hills. Saying that, we have the same views from our studio. Pop along and see them for yourself! Refreshments and a warm welcome await.

Directions: Once you enter Newton of Falkland, turn onto Holm Road behind the Malt Barn. Take the first left onto South Maltings (there will be a field on your left and back of the distillery on the right). Turn right into the courtyard. Charonne is the middle property on the right.

Access: Studio is not easily accessible by wheelchair. Parking is available on Holm Road and across the street at the town hall.

Points of interest: Lots of history in the courtyard. The Maltings was a working whisky distillery for 350 years, with a brewery and stables alongside it. Today it is a beautiful courtyard setting steeped in history.

Directions: We are 10 miles off the M90 between Perth and Edinburgh. Travelling south take Exit 9, and follow signs for Glenfarg and Gateside to join A91. Before you get to the village of Falkland, turn right at the sign for Pillars of Hercules. Continue for 1/2 mile, and take the first left.

Access: Parking is available in front of our Woodland Workshop, second entrance to your left.

Points of interest: Surrounding our Woodland Hub there are many woodland walks to explore. Visit the Information Hub at the Stables to pick up maps, leaflets and where you will also find refreshments. The village of Falkland is within walking distance with many lovely shops and Falkland Palace and Gardens.
