
This year we are fortunate again to be able to offer a bursary generously sponsored by the Howe of Fife Rotary Club. The money is



From Dundee direction, drive along the main street to the far end of town and turn left before the bowling green. Look for the red door, entry to the studio is along the alley to the left of door.

**Access:** Large free car park 100 yards away. From Perth, on the left after 30 mph sign, from Dundee, on right after bowling green. Wheelchair access on request.


## Jane Murray<sup>4</sup>
